



MUMBAI STREET LAB 2019

Key Information

1. Eligibility criteria:

- a. At least one of the team members should fulfill the following criteria:

Should be an architect with a minimum of 5 years of experience of working on relevant urban design projects either in their individual capacity or while working with an organization.

OR

Should possess a Master's degree in Urban Design/Planning/Landscape Architecture/allied fields with a minimum of 3 years of experience of working on relevant urban design projects either in their individual capacity or while working with an organization.

- b. This Lab is open to all residents of India, irrespective of location, who fulfill the eligibility criteria. It is not mandatory for applicants to be residents of Mumbai. However, they must be available for the in-person jury (if shortlisted) and for the entire time period of the Studio (if adjudged winner) to attend all meetings, workshops and site visits as required. They will also have to ensure their presence in Mumbai to supervise the construction work at least once every 15 days.

2. Memorandum of Understanding:

The MoU between the team members can be submitted at a later stage of the competition.

3. Survey Data & Counts:

Applicants can create an account on the website by clicking on the 'Apply' button located next to 'FAQ'. Survey data and counts will be available to download after logging in to the account.

4. Site Preferences:

Site Preferences selected during the registration process are not binding. Applicants may change their preferences later and submit proposals for any of the five streets they wish to.
